General Terms & Conditions:

- 1. The Purchase Committee will open the tenders on the date, time, and at the location specified in this Document.
- **2.** If the specified date for tender opening falls on a holiday or is declared a closed day for the Purchase Committee, the tenders will be opened at the prescribed time and place on the next business day.
- **3.** Only computer-printed tenders will be accepted. Handwritten tenders will not be valid.
- **4.** The Party shall submit samples of each item, duly signed by the authorized signatory mentioned above. Management reserves the right to:
- Split the total order quantity among all successful tender parties.
- Make any other decisions deemed necessary.
- 5. Sample Quantities:
- a) Herbs, Excipients, Preservatives, & Extracts: Not less than 100 grams.
- b) Minerals, Oils, Ghee, Honey, Guggulu, Rasot, Alua: 150 grams or more.
- c) Bhasma, Hing: 50 grams.
- d) Praval, Mukta, Mastagi, Para: 50 grams.
- e) Kesar: 10 grams.
- f) Silver Foil: 10 grams or 02 Gaddi.

Notes:



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- Samples provided by the bidders will not be returned under any circumstances.
- The format must be duly filled, signed, and stamped by the authorized signatory.
- Requests to consider EMD submitted in previous tenders as EMD for the current tender will not be entertained or considered.
- Each party shall quote a single price for each item and submit only one sample per item.
- **6.** Goods and Services Tax (GST), if applicable, shall be shown separately and in addition to the quoted price.
- 7. An Integrity Pact shall be executed between the Company and the successful bidders as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Ayush, Government of India, vide its O.M. C-31018/5/2022-VIG.
- **8.** Material supply must adhere to Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) standards. Packaging must be in GMP-certified bags (Jute bags are not permitted).
- 9. In case of failure to supply any material within the specified time, the order for such material shall be treated as void, and re-procurement shall be made from the next eligible party (L2, L3, and so on). Any difference in cost shall be borne by the defaulting party. Furthermore, the defaulting party may be debarred from supplying the failed material for the next three succeeding years or for a period at the discretion of Indian Medicines Pharmaceutical Corporation Limited (IMPCL).
- 10. Rejected items, if any, must be collected by the supplier at their own cost within 10 days of the rejection report. In case of rejection, as the original Purchase Order has been completed, the supplier is required to submit a new Purchase Order request for the supply of the rejected item(s) within 2 days.
- 11. In the case of goods controlled by the Government, the quotations must not exceed the controlled price. Quotations for controlled goods must be clearly indicated in the quotation, preferably marked in red ink.
- **12.** Conditional offers shall not be accepted under any circumstances.
- **13.** The company shall not be responsible for any delay, loss, or non-receipt of quotations sent by post and is not obligated to entertain any correspondence in this regard.
- **14.** The offer shall be disregarded in cases where information is incomplete, or any data/documents are not duly filled or furnished.
- 15. Payment Terms:
- **General Vendors:** Payment will be made within 75 days after the final inspection and approval of goods by the Company.
- **MSE Vendors:** Payment will be made within 45 days after the final inspection and approval of goods by the Company
- **16.** EMD and other exemptions, as per the MSMED Act, 2006, will be granted to bidders only for products/items where the bidder is eligible to claim MSE benefits.
- 17. If the bidder is an MSME for a specific product/item, they must raise a separate invoice for that item. This invoice must clearly state the MSME status and be accompanied by a valid Udyam Registration Certificate as per the MSMED Act, 2006.



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- **18.** The MSME policy is specifically designed to encourage procurement of goods and services directly from Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs). To qualify for MSME benefits, a bidder must:
 - **Be the actual manufacturer:** The bidder must have manufactured the quoted item(s) themselves.
 - **Provide proof of manufacturing:** This could include documents like manufacturing licenses, production records, or other relevant certifications.
 - **Have a valid Udyam registration:** This is the official registration for MSMEs in India
 - Traders are not eligible for MSE benefits under this policy. This is because the policy aims to directly support the growth and development of actual manufacturing units within the MSME sector.
- 19. IMPCL is registered on the Trade Receivables Electronic Discounting System (TReDS) platform of A. TREDS Ltd (Invoicement). MSME vendors can avail the benefit of bills discounting through this platform.
- **20.** All submitted documents and papers should be properly numbered.
- **21.** Management reserves the right, in case of urgency, to directly procure materials from the following sources:
- Manufacturers
- Associations
- Exporters/Importers
- Authorized agents recognized by Government institutions/autonomous bodies.
- **22.** Eligible MSMEs will be given preference as per Government rules. All tender-related documents must be duly stamped and signed by the Authorized Signatory.
- **23. Amendments to Tender Enquiry Documents**: The purchaser reserves the right to modify the Tender Enquiry documents by issuing amendments before the tender submission deadline. These amendments will be published on the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) website (https://etenders.gov.in). Bidders are encouraged to visit the CPPP website regularly for updates.
- **24. Tender Validity**: Tenders shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 365 days from the date of opening of the Price Bid. The tender validity may be further extended with mutual consent beyond this period, subject to satisfactory justification.
- **25. Quality of Supplied Material Vis-à-vis Approved Samples**: Approved vendors are advised to supply the materials strictly as per the samples provided with the national tender, failing which the whole lot of material will be out rightly rejected.
- 26. Wharf age Lifting of Rejected Material:
 - Supplier shall lift rejected material(s) within **15 days of intimation** from the Purchase Section. A grace period of 7 days shall be provided without charges.
 - Beyond this period, **Wharf age Charges** @ ₹2.00 per kg per week (minimum ₹500 per consignment per week; maximum 5% of the value of rejected goods) will be levied.
 - If rejected material is not lifted within **6 weeks**, the Company reserves the right to dispose of the same at supplier's **risk and cost**, and expenses/losses shall be recovered from pending bills, security deposit, or other dues.
- **27.** Supplier may alternatively authorize the Company in writing for safe disposal of rejected material on their behalf.



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28. PREPARATION OF TENDERS

Documents Comprising the Tender

The online Two-Bid System, comprising a "Technical Bid" and a "Price Bid," shall be prepared by the tenderer as follows:

Technical Bid

1. Earnest Money:

- o Earnest money furnished in accordance with tender conditions.
- Alternatively, documentary evidence as per tender conditions for claiming exemption from payment of earnest money.
- 2. Tender Form (Unpriced): The tender form must be submitted without any prices filled in.
- **3. Eligibility and Qualification:** Documentary evidence demonstrating the tenderer's eligibility to submit the tender and their qualifications to perform the contract if their tender is accepted.
- **4. Power of Attorney/Authorization:** Power of Attorney/Authorization in favour of the signatory of tender documents. If the signatory is not a director, the format provided in the tender document must be typed/printed on stamp paper of Rs. 100/-.
- **5.** List of quoted items.
- **6. Certificate of Incorporation / Registration:** Certificate of Incorporation / Registration of the company/organization.
- **7. Statement of Deviations:** A statement outlining any deviations from the tendered technical specifications.
- **8. Statement of No Deviations:** A statement confirming adherence to commercial terms and conditions.
- **9. RTGS/NEFT Format:** Duly filled, signed, and stamped copy of the RTGS/NEFT format for E-payment.
- **10. List of Purchase Orders/Invoices:** A list of Purchase Orders/Invoices uploaded against the Eligibility Criteria.

29. AWARD OF CONTRACT

Purchaser's Right to Accept or Reject Tenders: The purchaser reserves the right to accept any tender in part or in full, reject any or all tenders, or cancel the tendering process and reject all tenders at any time prior to the award of the contract without incurring any liability to the affected tenderer(s).

Variation of Quantities:

a. At the time of awarding the contract or during the currency of the contract, the purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity of raw materials.



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- b. The maximum permissible increase in quantity is 100%, and the maximum permissible decrease is 0%.
- c. The total quantity may be procured from any of the empaneled tenderers whose samples are approved and who are willing to match the L1 (lowest) rates. However, IMPCL shall have no obligation to procure exclusively from the L1 tenderer. Procurement shall be made from any of the approved sample holders at the matched L1 rate, as per requirement.
- **30. Terms of Delivery**: Goods shall be delivered by the supplier in accordance with the terms of delivery specified in the Purchase Order. Delivery will be F.O.R. Mohan or as per the specific requirements of the company.
- **31. Insurance**: The supplier shall be responsible for insuring the goods against loss or damage that may occur during manufacturing, acquisition, transportation, storage, and delivery. The supplier shall ensure that all goods are delivered to the destination in good condition. The supplier shall be responsible for obtaining all-risk transit insurance to cover any potential losses during transportation.
- **32. Distribution of Dispatch Documents for Clearance/Receipt of Goods**: The supplier shall submit all relevant dispatch documents within 24 hours of supplying the goods, ensuring compliance with all applicable statutory requirements.
- **33. Taxes and Duties**: The supplier shall be solely responsible for all taxes, duties, fees, levies, and other applicable charges incurred until the successful delivery of the contracted goods to the purchaser.
- **34. Assignment**: The Supplier shall not assign, either in whole or in part, its contractual duties, responsibilities, and obligations under this contract to any third party without the prior written consent of the Purchaser.
- **35. Subcontracts**: The Supplier shall notify the Purchaser in writing of all subcontracts awarded under this contract, if not already specified in its original tender submission. Such notification, whether provided in the original tender or subsequently, shall not relieve the Supplier of any of its liabilities or obligations under the terms and conditions of this contract.
- **36. Delay in supplies:** LD a sum equivalent to 0.5 (half) percent (Max up to 10%) of the prices of any portion of items delivered late, for each week or part thereof of delay.
- **37. Governing Language**: The contract shall be written in English. All correspondence and other documents exchanged between the parties pertaining to this contract shall be written in English or Hindi.
- **38. Resolution of Disputes**: If any dispute or difference arises between the Purchaser/Consignee and the Supplier in connection with or relating to this contract, the parties shall endeavour to resolve the same amicably through mutual consultations. If the parties fail to resolve the dispute or difference through mutual consultation within twenty-one (21) days of its occurrence, the matter may be referred to the competent Civil Court in New Delhi.

39. Eligibility Criteria:

- **Business Continuity:** The bidder firm must have been actively engaged in the supply/manufacturing of raw materials for the past two years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year (FY 2024-25).
- **Experience:** Bidders must demonstrate experience in successfully completing manufacturing/dealing in similar supplies to those being solicited in this tender. This experience can be evidenced by submitting:



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- Option a: Two (02) Purchase Orders (photocopies) or Invoices (photocopies) from Government or reputable firms for similar raw material supplies, with a minimum value of 80 Lacs in the last five years.
- Option b: Four (04) Purchase Orders (photocopies) or Invoices (photocopies) from Government or reputable firms for similar raw material supplies, with a minimum value of 40 Lacs in the last five years.
- Option c: Six (06) Purchase Orders (photocopies) or Invoices (photocopies) from Government or reputable firms for similar raw material supplies, with a minimum value of 27 Lacs in the last five years.
- Option d: Eight (08) Purchase Orders (photocopies) or Invoices (photocopies) from Government or reputable firms for similar raw material supplies, with a minimum value of 20 Lacs in the last five years.

NOTE: IT IS MANDATORY FOR BIDDERS TO SUBMIT A LIST OF PURCHASE ORDERS (POS) AND/OR INVOICES IN SUPPORT OF THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA; OTHERWISE, THE BID WILL BE REJECTED.

- **Note:** Relaxations may be granted to Start-up's and Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) as per government policies.
- **40. Tender Download and Submission**: The tender document can be downloaded and must be submitted electronically through the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) only: https://etenders.gov.in (e-tender portal for PSUs).

Instructions for Online Bid Submission:

1. **GENERAL**

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at: https://etenders.gov.in.

2. REGISTRATION

- a) Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: https://etenders.gov.in) by clicking on the link "Online bidder Enrollment" on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
- b) As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- c) Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- d) Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by



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CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.

- e) Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC's to others which may lead to misuse.
- f) Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC /e-Token.

3. SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

- a) There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, Organization Name, Location, Date, Value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as Organization Name, Form of Contract, Location, Date, Other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- b) Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e- mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- c) The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

4. PREPARATION OF BIDS

- a) Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.
- b) Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- c) Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be uploaded as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF/JPG formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.
- d) To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of



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standard documents which are required to be uploaded as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use "My Space" or "Other Important Documents" area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the "My Space" area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

5. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- a) Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that they can upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- b) The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- c) Tender fee / Tender document cost: Bidder has to select the instrument type & enter the details of transaction of payment of tender fee / tender document cost done by RTGS / NEFT / IMPS as applicable and upload scanned copy of transaction receipt as documentary proof for payment. For further details, tenderer may refer clause C18of ITT.
- d) Bidder should upload the scanned copy of undertaking for tender security declaration as per the instructions specified in tender documents. Otherwise the uploaded bid will be rejected.
- e) Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the white colored (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the file name. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.
- f) The server time (which is displayed on the bidders' dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.
- g) All the documents being uploaded by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The



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data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128-bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done. Any bid document that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric encryption using a system generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/bid openers public keys. Overall, the uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.

- h) The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.
- i) Upon the successful and timely submission of bids (i.e. after Clicking "Freeze Bid Submission" in the portal), the portal will give a successful bid submission message & a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.
- j) The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the bid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass for any bid opening meetings.

6. ASSISTANCE TO BIDDERS

- a. Any queries relating to the tender document and the terms and conditions contained therein should be addressed to the Tender Inviting Authority for a tender or the relevant contact person indicated in the tender.
